


Find The Twins

OSTRICH


He is the biggest bird in the world!

Ostriches have wonderful fluffy feathers on their backs, and like to spend their time on the sandy plains of Africa and Arabia.







The largest elephant is 14 feet high which is about two and a half times as tall as your Daddy. He is very strong and heavy. The elephant has large ears and a long trunk that sucks in the water he wants to drink. Then, he curls his trunk, still holding the water inside it, and carries it up and puts it into his mouth - a little bit like a straw. This is how elephants drink. Elephants are used for carrying things for people, the way we use trucks or trains here in America. Though the elephant is very strong and sometimes dangerous, he can also be very gentle.






This is a PENGUIN
